Zoom Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 1:58 p.m. CST. Rodney Boland did the invocation. The roll was called and was answered by President Mandy Heslep-Whitten, Vice President Charley Peters, Treasurer Anita Pfiefer, Secretary Deena Frakes and Past President Rodney Boland.

The motion was made and seconded to record that the Email Coordinator is to be paid \$600 quarterly upon submission of a voucher, that the amount be included in the Payment Schedule and the 2022 Budget be changed to show \$3000 for the FY. Adopted.

Information was given that donations to the Veteran's Project are not tax deductible.

There have been questions about administration of the UPMA Retired Facebook page and what can and can't be posted on it. Anita will send of guidelines that another organization uses for us to consider. President Mandy asked that we all think about it and be prepared to discuss it at our next meeting.

There are over 300 Retirees and 55 guests registered for the 2022 National Convention. A retired CT Postmaster has offered a quartet (possibly acapella) to entertain at the Retiree Luncheon at no cost to us. Mandy will do further research on it before committing to them.

Motion and second to give a \$300 per year stipend to the President for purchase of ink, paper and other necessary supplies. Adopted.

Mandy reported that she will go to St. Louis to do more convention planning on April 24th and will report back to us.

Other topics of discussion but no action were Nebraska Retired Chapter, Membership, and Postal Reform.

Motion was made to adjourn at 2:49 p.m. and was adopted after it was seconded.
